Senior Lecturer in Agri-Food Science

- Supervision of student projects, end-of-study projects
- Networking with all the actors of the ag-food sector

- Methodological and technological skills of the candidate will allow him/her to fit into the Transformation & Agroresources research unit
- She/he will contribute to the elaboration, implementation and development of scientific collaboration with public and private R&D departments as well as with companies
- She /He will promote the results of research by writing scientific articles and attending conferences at national and international levels
